

E-Pub & Audiobooks continued..

How to Renew

1. On your library Bookshelf, select the **Renew** icon next to the title, which will appear three days before the title expires.
2. If no holds exist on the title, the **Renew** icon will be green and you can renew at that point.
3. If holds exist on the title, the **Renew** icon will be grayed out. If desired, still renew to reserve a spot on the title's wait list so that you can borrow it again.
4. Enter and confirm your email address in the renewal form that opens, and then click the **Renew** button.
5. Once renewed, the icon will have a **checkmark** next to it.
6. As soon as your first checkout expires you will receive an email notification to borrow the title again. Follow the normal check-out process.

Return Early

1. From your Overdrive App on the Kindle Fire, go back to the **Bookshelf** on the left pane.
2. Tap and hold on the book cover. Tap **Delete** to remove from the device or tap **Return** to return a title early.





You will need a valid library card and the ability to download the Overdrive App for Kindle Fire/Fired HD.

Amazon Kindle

You will need:

- ◆ Wi-Fi access for over the air transfer
- ◆ Amazon ID (username and password)
- ◆ Valid Library Card

Adding a book to my device:

1. From a computer, go to <https://akronlibrary.overdrive.com>
2. Browse collection to find a book.
3. Click the Book Cover or **Borrow** button.
4. Enter your ASCPL Barcode # and PIN #.
5. You will see the notification bar on your screen to go to the **Loans** page. Limit of 20 titles checked out at any time) Click on **Loans**.
6. On next screen, click the drop-down to CHOOSE A FORMAT and click on **Kindle Book**.
7. You will be taken to Amazon's webpage, click on the button **Get Library Book**.
8. Sign in with your Amazon User ID and password when you arrive at Amazon.
9. Select your Kindle device or reading app.
10. Click **Continue**.
11. The library book will be downloaded (via Wi-Fi) to your Kindle.

Returning a Kindle book early

1. On your computer, go to www.amazon.com.
2. Sign in to your account.
3. Select **Manage Your Content and Devices** under the **Account & Lists** drop-down near the top right.
4. Under the heading - **Actions** ; click on the button next to the title you wish to return. A box will pop up.
5. Tap **Return this book**.
6. When prompted, tap **Yes**.

Amazon Kindle Fire Kindle Books

You will need:

- ◆ Wi-Fi access for over the air transfer
- ◆ Amazon ID (username and password)
- ◆ Valid Library Card

Adding a book to my device:

1. From your device, via the **Web** menu, go to <https://akronlibrary.overdrive.com>.
2. Browse collection to find a book.
3. Tap the **Book Cover**.
4. Tap on the **Borrow** button.
5. Enter your ASCPL Barcode # and PIN.
6. Tap on **Go To Loans** button. (Limit of 20 titles checked out at any time)
7. Tap the drop-down arrow next to **Choose A Format** button.
8. Select **Kindle Book**.
9. You will be taken to Amazon's webpage, click on the button **Get Library Book**.
10. You must sign in with your Amazon account if you are not already logged in.
11. Select your Kindle device. Tap **Continue**. The library book will be downloaded (via the Wi-Fi) to your Kindle.
12. Book will appear on your carousel. (**Note:** You may need to use the widget on top right to **Sync**.)
13. Tap the book to open.

Returning a Kindle book early

1. On your Kindle Fire, via the **Web** menu, go to www.amazon.com.
2. Sign in to your account.
3. Tap Manage Your Content and Devices near the top right.
4. Under the heading - **Actions** ; tap the button next to the title you wish to return. A box will pop up.
5. Tap **Return this book**.
6. When prompted, tap **Yes**.

Amazon Kindle Fire E-Pub books and Audiobooks

You will need:

- ◆ Wi-Fi access for over the air transfer
 - ◆ Overdrive App
 - ◆ Valid Library Card
1. Download the **OverDrive Media Console App** by searching for it in your Amazon App Store.
 2. Tap **Install**.
 3. Open the Overdrive App and follow the prompts to create an Overdrive account.
 4. Open the Overdrive App.
 5. Tap **Settings** button then *Get Books* (on a regular Kindle Fire) or a book with a plus sign (on a Kindle Fire HD). First time users have to add the Akron Summit County Public Library on your device.
 6. Tap on **Add Library**.
 7. Search your zip code.
 8. Tap on one of the **Akron-Summit County Public Library** branch locations.
 9. Tap the **yellow star** button next to the library name so that your device will remember the library
 10. Tap the library name and start browsing for an e-book or audiobook.
 11. Tap the **book cover**.
 12. Tap the **borrow button**.
 13. Enter your ASCPL Barcode # and PIN #. You will see the notification bar on your screen to go to the **Loans** page. Tap on **Loans**.
 14. Tap the drop-down arrow next to **Choose A Format** button. Tap **E-Pub** ebook or **MP3** audio book Box.
 15. Tap **Add to App**.
 16. You will see **Loading New Title** message on screen.
 17. Tap on menu button and go to **Bookshelf** to open the book.
