ACQUISITION: Donated by Christopher McKnight on August 18, 2011.

- ACCESS: Restricted access; materials fragile; access by request at Akron-Summit County Public Library's Main Library Special Collections division only.
- VOLUME: 5 boxes, 14 binders, 2 folders, 2 books, 17 plaques and proclamations, 60 large portrait photos, 1 street sign. Approximately 21LF.
- BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: The Akron Jaycees was founded in 1932. It is a non-profit organization emphasizing civic leadership skills, business development, and community service projects.
- SCOPE AND CONTENT: This collection consists of documents, photographs, and items or realia produced by the Akron Jaycees, 1930s 2000s. Documents include newsletters, clippings, project and event planning records, and records pertaining to anniversary celebrations.
- ARRANGEMENT: The collection is divided into seven series based on format or general document subject. Original order within folders and binders has been maintained.

#### **SERIES 1: Newsletters**

5 binders. Various titles covering the late 1940s through early 2000s.

#### **SERIES 2: Publicity**

1 binder. Mostly news clippings.

## **SERIES 3: Photos and slides**

2 boxes and 4 binders covering various events and 60 large portrait photos.

## **SERIES 4: Project documents**

2 boxes containing records relating to various community service projects.

## **SERIES 5: Internal programming and anniversaries**

1 box including administrative documents and prepared organizational histories.

## **SERIES 6: Realia**

1 box of promotional and commemorative items including 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary banner; plaques and proclamations; 2 books: *A Legacy of Leadership* by John W. Clark and *It's a Good Life* by C. William Brownfield; large street sign.

## SERIES 7: Jaycee wives/Women's Auxiliary

4 binders, 2 folders. Photos and documents relating to the auxiliary organization 1940s-1980s, including news clippings relating to women's full admittance to the Jaycees in 1984.
