BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Collected by the Denton family.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Documents and pictures of the Furnace Street Mission and Victim Assistance Program, including information on the founder of the FSM, Reverend William "Bill" Denton, the second generation of FSM and founder of VAP, Reverend Robert "Bob" Denton, and family from 1926-2000s. Further Akron Beacon Journal articles relating to FSM/VAP and associates can be searched online.

ARRANGEMENT: The collection is divided into two series: Furnace Street Mission (FSM) and the Victim Assistance Program (VAP). Each series is grouped by like materials and in general chronology when available.
