BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: D. Bruce Mansfield was the president of Ohio Edison from 1964 until his retirement in 1975. In addition, he was an active leader in many community organizations, including United Way of Summit County, the Akron Chamber of Commerce, and the Summit County Charter Commission. His obituary appeared in the Akron Beacon Journal on March 8, 1985; that of his wife, Louise, appeared on October 6, 2006.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: This collection consists of materials pertaining to the professional and personal life of D. Bruce Mansfield, approximately 1930 – 1986. It includes scrapbooks, photographs, diplomas, awards, and plaques. It also includes photographs related to the construction of what is now the First Energy building across from the Library.

Photographs, 1974. Unidentified occasion; probably groundbreaking for the Ohio Edison/First Energy building. The exact date of this occasion is not yet known; photographs were developed in December 1974. According to the Summit County Historical Society's photo of the building (SC photo files 2003-522-170), construction was completed in October 1976. Photographs were originally in the binder embossed "Wyatt C. Hedrick Architects and Engineers, Inc." This binder also included copies of miscellaneous newspaper clippings, some dated 1968.
