BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH: Although Robert O. Orr (1918-2005) was born in Colorado Springs, he lived most of his life in Akron, Ohio and graduated from St. Vincent High School in 1939. He served during World War II and was awarded the Bronze Star and the Combat Infantryman's Badge.

Owen O. Orr, Robert's father, founded Motor Cargo, Inc in Akron in the 1930s. Robert served as president for many years as well as holding business interests in Triple-O Oil Sales and Service. Robert was also an accomplished midget auto racer and golfer. Robert and his wife Annamae (nee Gifford d. 1996) had no children.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: This collection contains both business and personal items. There are photographs, newspaper clippings, artifacts and other material relating the trucking industry and the various businesses owned by both Robert and Owen Orr. These include Motor Cargo and Triple O Service and Supply. There are several artifacts that most likely resided in the offices of Motor Cargo Inc., if not on the desks of Robert Orr and his father Owen Orr. There are no financial or employee records but there is a nearly complete run of the corporate newsletter for Motor Cargo – *The Cargoite*. All of the information relating to businesses owned by the Orr Family can be found in Series 1.

The personal records in this collection are comprised of information concerning World War II, the Orr family and Robert's favorite pastimes. Robert Orr's service in the Army (European theatre) during World War II is documented primarily through photographs. There are also ration books and stamps. The many family photographs date from the 1870s to 2000. There are photographs, programs, and newspaper clippings relating to Robert Orr's long time hobby as a driver in midget auto races. Robert's skill in golf and fishing are also documented through awards and photographs. Other than a Father's Day card, there is no family correspondence. All of this information can be found in Series 2.
