

Further Description of Important Features
wood frame house with the story and one-half Greek revival form and the shallow roof and side wing common to the style. The vertical 2x2 windows, the shed roof porch, the corbelled chimney, and the full height fenestration on the lower facade are early Victorian features.



History and Significance
After graduating from Starling Medical College in 1858, Dr. Randall moved to Hammond's Corners to begin his practice. He built up a large practice and was known as a leader in the use of new remedies which gave him a surprising rate of success. He married in 1863. He was a Republican and an advocate of equal rights and reform.

Description of Environment and Outbuildings
The house stands among homes dating from a variety of periods near the center of Bath.
