ACQUISITION: Ohio Department of Health, Vital Statistics donated the reports in 2008.

ACCESS: Restricted access; materials fragile; access by request at Akron-Summit County Public Library's Main Library Special Collections division only.

VOLUME: 14 boxes

RELATED COLLECTIONS: The Veterans Grave Registration Cards Collection contains similar information for burials prior to 1941. The Lutz Collection of Veterans' Burial Cards contains cards for veterans of the Spanish-American War (1898), Revolutionary War (1775-1783), Civil War (1861-1865), War of 1812 (1812-1814), and World War I (1914-1918)

SCOPE AND CONTENT: The General Code of Ohio requires the Ohio Department of Health to distribute to County Recorders lists of Ohio Veterans who have died. The reports were issued monthly beginning in May of 1941 and contain all of the Ohio veterans who died sorted by County. Beginning in 1990, the reports were limited to Summit County only. Each report contains the veteran's name, date of birth and burial, some service information, and cemetery information.
