

42. Further Description of Important Features Large Greek Revival structure with full pediments in each gable. 2 X 2 windows with plain surrounds. Central sidelighted entrance with full entablature and Ionic pilasters. Double entrances on inside corner with a continuous architrave and fluted Doric pilasters. There is a modern, one storey wing.

43. History and Significance
This structure was used by E. H. Jagger as a store in 1856. By 1874, Dustin Johnson owned the property. The building's size and unusual number of entries suggests that it had an early commercial function.

44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings
The structure stands near the road with a gas station to one side and a parking lot and modern addition to the other.
