Art Arfons Collection Special Collections – Akron-Summit County Public Library

ACQUISITION: Thomas Joswick, nephew of Walt Arfons and Art Arfons, donated the material to the Special Collections Division of the Akron-Summit County Public Library in March of 2022.

ACCESS: Restricted access; materials fragile; access by request at Akron-Summit County Public Library's Main Library Special Collections Division only.

VOLUME: 3 boxes and 1 oversize folder, Approx. 1.25 linear foot.

- BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Summit County natives Walter (1916-2013) and Art Arfons (1926-2007) built and raced jet-powered dragsters. They began building racers together in 1952, but by 1962 the brothers' careers diverged with each developing their own design innovations. Their most popularly recognized cars were named "Wingfoot Express" and "The Green Monster." Art Arfons broke the land speed record at Bonneville Salt Flats, Utah in 1964-65.
- SCOPE AND CONTENT: Photographs, clippings, correspondence related to drag cars and drag car racing. Of interest to researchers are photographs of both Walt and Art Arfons racing as well as press photos from the Firestone Company regarding Art Arfons' record-breaking runs. The bulk of material includes magazines from the late1950s to the mid-1970s that feature articles about Art Arfons' career.
- ARRANGEMENT: This collection is divided into four series: Biographical Info, Correspondence, and Career Highlights, Photographs, Periodicals, and Clippings. Each series is grouped by like materials and in general chronologically with undated material last.
