Dr. Raymond S. Baby, Curator of Archaeology, Ohio Historical Society, has examined the site and states:

'The Fort Island Works, an oval-shaped earthen enclosure built and occupied by the Late Woodland Indians, is an important site. It is not only one of the best preserved sites in the state of Ohio but the only one of its kind still in existence in northern Ohio. Three similar works near Norwalk, Ohio, surveyed by Col. Charles Whittlesey, are now obliterated.
