## Building Our Future

ASCPL has launched a systemwide capital improvement plan, funded by a voter-approved 1-mill, 20-year bond generating \$160 million exclusively for building and infrastructure upgrades. With an average building age of 24 years, ASCPL locations require major repairs, modernized layouts, and enhanced technology to meet evolving community needs. Guided by a 2025 space usage study and extensive public input, improvements will reach all 19 locations. ## Services Provided

- **1,193,358** physical items in the Library's collection with access to millions more through SearchOhio and OhioLINK
- **7,409** Library programs offered
- **139,835** people attended Library programs
- **167,754** uses of public computers
- **2,164** U.S. passports processed and 1,537 U.S. passport photos taken (available at Main Library and Nardon Hills Branch)
- **1,503,863** items checked out via digital services including Hoopla, Kanopy, and Libby
- **5,112** appointments in the TechZone@Main for 3D printing, vinyl printing, laser engraving, multimedia recording studios, and more
- **49,928** visitors to three bookmobiles that travelled 14,792 miles
- **12,753** after school snacks served
