Alender, Katie. The Companion, 2021. TEEN ALENDER Companion

Margot survives a horrible car accident that kills her entire family and is sent to live at Palmer House, a home for youth that have nowhere to stay. She suffers from such intense nightmares from her trauma that she often screams out in the night. Then a prestigious foster family chooses her to live with them at their country estate so that she can be a companion to their silent, mysterious daughter. At first Margot feels calmer with her new family and her nightmares subside, but as time goes by her isolation in the new house begins to play tricks on her mind and then the real nightmare begins.

Gould, Courtney. The Dead and the Dark, 2021. TEENGOULD Dead

Something is wrong in Snakebite, Oregon. Teenagers are going missing or turning up dead, the weather isn't normal and it all started when TV's most popular ghost hunters arrived in town. Ashley Barton's boyfriend is the first teen to go missing and so she teams up with the ghost hunters to find out what has happened to him. After Jane discovers that the "storage room" her mother has kept locked for years is not actually empty, but is inhabited by the spirit of a little girl, she starts to question her own sanity.
